### DARK MATERIAL EVA AND FRANCO MATTES

Since social media's growth into a multibillion-dollar industry, a massive labour force handles content moderation - the removal of offensive material for social-networking sites. At work in their cubicles and apartments in the Philippines, Arizona or Bulgaria, miles away from the source, workers on filtering farms are employed to soak up the worst of humanity in order to protect the rest of us. For this new work Eva and Franco Mattes contacted several content moderators to talk about the most affecting videos and images they encountered. Even if they left the job long ago, most can still recall the video that made them quit. These filtered images may disappear from the internet but they are also going to unfortunately stick to the brains of an invisible army of moderators.
